Another \$2 Million Collected

Our motorcycle client was in the process of making a right turn when he was rear-ended. His feet were pinned against his exhaust pipe and he suffered a broken ankle, fractures to two toes and a puncture wound.

Our client and his brother were riding their motorcycles on a clear summer evening in Ozaukee County, Wisconsin. They were cruising down the highway when a lawnmower pulled out in front of them. Our client's brother swerved out of the way, while our client braked to avoid the collision but was unable to avoid hitting the lawnmower.

The insurance company's initial offer was \$5,000. They hired a reconstructionist who alleged our client was speeding excessively.

Attorney Todd Korb took the case to trial, and the jury awarded a \$422,000 verdict.

More Young Pedestrians on the Road - HELP SAVE LIVES

It's back-to-school time, and Hupy and Abraham, S.C. wants to remind parents and motorists alike to expect — and protect — the increased number of young pedestrians on our roads.

Pedestrian fatality data shows over 6,000 pedestrians were killed in collisions with automobiles in 2016, the highest number of pedestrian deaths in over 20 years. To help combat this increasing number of pedestrian accidents, the law firm recently created and fully funded a public service announcement spreading the important message that yielding to pedestrians in Wisconsin is not optional, it is the law. One of the actors in the PSA is a staff member of the law firm. The PSA was created within a four-block radius of the office and the recent fatal accident.

Hupy and Abraham, S.C. has developed multiple potentially life-saving PSAs that have aired on television in Wisconsin, Illinois and Iowa thousands of times in the past year. The law firm also created a "YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS" bumper sticker that is mailed to those who request it through the firm's website, hupy.com, as well as handed out at events. This free bumper sticker was also produced, at the cost of the firm, to help prevent serious accidents. More than 35,000 stickers have been distributed to date.

With pedestrian death statistics growing at an alarming rate in Milwaukee, Attorney Hupy has exerted his activism and been an active, founding member of MiIWALKee Walks, a coalition aiming to spread awareness and prevent pedestrian-vehicle incidents.

MiIWALKee Walks seeks to start a public dialogue with law enforcement to both prevent the number of pedestrian-vehicle accidents and issue more traffic tickets to motorists who fail to yield to pedestrians. The effort will especially target Milwaukee's diverse neighborhoods and income differences. Children in lower-income neighborhoods are five times more likely to be injured as pedestrians than children in other neighborhoods.

Younger pedestrians are more vulnerable than adults. While children are often hard to see and behave unpredictably, teens are more likely to be distracted while out and about. The pedestrian death rate among teens is twice that of younger children. It is the responsibility of all motorists to watch for children and teens, especially during times when they may be traveling to and from school.

5 Steps to Keep Kids Safe:

1. Do not expect kids to follow the law.
2. Stop at all crosswalks.
3. Reduce distractions.
4. Slow down.
5. Look twice before backing up.

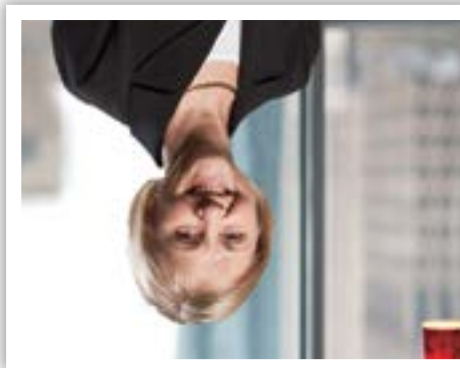
